### 2. Approval of May 18, 2023 Minutes – Voting Item

## 3. Update – Unsheltered Study and Next Steps

- Polk County Homeless Service Providers came together for two facilitated sessions to process the results of the study and begin to prioritize a plan of action to better serve folks within the system.
- Two work groups are moving forward. One focuses on getting different systems to work better together. The second group is working on shelter for people who identify as women.

# 4. Update – Street Outreach Coordination and Connections

- Amber Lewis, City of DSM Homeless Policy Coordinator, shared about her role and meeting with partners in the homeless system.
- There are different kinds of street outreach some focus on housing conversations while others focus on basic needs.
- Street outreach providers currently meet monthly to talk about specific people who are unsheltered that they are working to find housing.
- Amber and Homeward staff are putting together a work group to look at street outreach policies.

### 5. Point in Time – Summer Count Analysis

- Summer PIT took place from noon 7/19 through noon on 7/20. It is an important tool in our community to understand the number of folks experiencing unsheltered homelessness, make connections, etc.
- Kasper Kittredge presented information regarding the Summer 2023 Point in Time count.
  - 633 people were homeless in the 2023 Summer PIT as compared to 628 in 2022. The 2023 Winter PIT had 606 people.
  - 184 people were unsheltered in the 2023 Summer PIT the same as in Summer 2022. The 2023 Winter PIT had 129 people.

- 6 people aged 18-24 were unsheltered with the remaining were 25 and over.
- 14 people living unsheltered were veterans.
- Overall, the numbers were very similar to last year's summer count.

- Kasper Kittredge shared a streamlined dashboard for the Polk County/DSM Continuum of Care. It is newly developed. Please provide feedback about the new dashboard.
